Once again, the school is celebrating our best ever results both at 5+ A\*-C including English and Mathematics (54%) and 5+ A\*-C (71%). 100% of our students have at least 1 GCSE.

Our continuing focus on improvement has ensured that Heathcote's results have increased every year for the past ten years. As a Science College we are proud of our Science results which includes 100% A\*-C in Chemistry, Biology and 98% in Physics.

100% of our early entry Year 10 Mathematics cohort achieved A\*-B grades

Once again we are celebrating the excellent examination performance of Heathcote students. Every one of our students has achieved at least 5 grades between A\* and G, and more than 71% of our students achieved five GCSEs at A\*-C, the highest ever at Heathcote. 54% of our Year 11s were awarded A\*-C grades including English and Maths.

A number of students were proud of the high grades they scored: Sophie Henry came away with 4 A\* grades, and 7 at grade A; Samantha Potton achieved 3 A\* and 8 As; Ibrahim Hussain had 2 A\* along with his 8 A grades; Tristan Alcindor had 3 at A\* and 2 As along with 5 B grades;



Rosanna Brown achieved 8 grade As and Stephanie Notice gained 7 grade As.

There was great success in many subjects, including Expressive Arts, Statistics, Polish and BTEC Science all having a 100% pass-rate in the exams. 91% of Music candidates and 90% of Graphics students gained A\*-C grades. 84% of our students gained two or more GCSE grades in Science at C and above.





# Well done to all our students

Alongside the GCSE exams we celebrated the success of eleven students who gained the European Computer Driving Licence, 34 who gained Level 2 in the Adult Numeracy and Literacy exam and those who were successful in Leadership Awards: 13 Dance Leaders and 47 Junior Sports Leaders.

Success was not just confined to Year 11, a number of Year 9 and Year 10 students have been successful in examinations, too. The year 10 students who were entered early for Mathematics achieved 6 A\*s, 16 As and 8 Bs in the exam this summer.

Well done to all our students, we look forward to your continued success as you move on to the next stage of your education.
