Results soar again!

Highest results for 5+ A*- C including English and Maths.



Once again we were able to celebrate our excellent achievement on results day. Under the new measure of reporting 5+ A*- C grades including English and Maths, 50% of our students reached the target.

66% of students in Year 11 achieved 5 or more A*- C grades.

99% of the year group achieved 5 or more GCSE at grades A*- G, while every student achieved one or more GCSE grades, 100%!

Core subjects performed well again, some very high grades were gained in these areas.

A number of year 11s performed well in community Language GCSEs: Mehak Shahzad and Babar Khadam both had grade A for Urdu; Miguel Clemente and Simara Jau Cambanco gained As in Portugese; Khoyrul Islam had a C grade for Bengali; Sinem Somnez, Mehmet Seker and Fatma Sancı all gained A grades for Turkish, and Cosan Mehmet passed with a C; Christian Naykene gained an A grade for Italian.



Years 9 & 10 success

The results weren't just good for Year 11. The Year 10s who did the RE short course were very successful and many students achieved high grades.

Of the Year 10s who have completed their Science core course 63% have provisionally achieved A*- C grades.

100% passed in German
94% passed in French

Of the Year 9 and 10 students who were entered for Maths there were many successes, every student in the top Maths set from Year 10 passed the exam with a C grade or above. The top set Year 9 Maths group who took the GCSE all passed with C grades and above, and a number of them had A*s and some even scored full marks on the papers. Year 9s also took a foundation exam in Modern Foreign Languages, 100% passed in German, and 94% passed in French.





Wonderful results ??

Several students took exams in their Community Languages, with some wonderful results. Year 8 Students Pablo Etienne Escudero and Ismael Gonzalez-Patel gained A* and A grades in Spanish, Sophie Hereford in Year 9 also passed Spanish with a B grade, and Year 10 student Sheila Croft gained

an A for her Spanish. Students who took Turkish achieved high results: for Year 9s Ela Beyaz an A* and Deniz Demirelli a B; Andreia De Jesus in Year 9 and Alexandre Sanah in Year 10 both gained a B grade for Portugese.



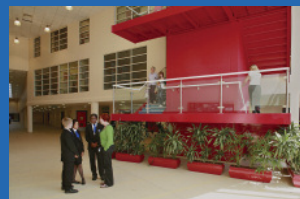
Some students can be very proud of the grades they achieved:
