Subject:	Length	What skills and knowledge are being assessed?
PE	30 mins	Phases of a warm-up and their significance in preparing for physical activity. Types of activities included in a warm up. Muscle names and locations Joint names and locations Components of fitness
DT	50 mins	Design communication - use of image and text to communicate a key message considering shape, colour, fine-detail and font design
Geography	50 mins	The three types of geography, the location of major continents and oceans in the world, important physical features in the UK, using latitude and longitude to find location, 4 and 6 figure grid references, OS Map symbols, using a scale to calculate distance, describing places using the 5Ws.
Science	30 mins	This examination will cover the following science knowledge: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forms 7.4 and 7.5: Unit 7A – Cells, tissues and organ systems • Forms 7.2 and 7.6: Unit 7E – Mixtures and separation • Forms 7.1 and 7.3: Unit 7I - Energy This examination will assess students' science skills: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conventions in writing and using microscopes (Unit 7A) • Writing a method and safety when heating (Unit 7E) • Fair comparisons and ratios, summarising ideas (Unit 7I)
Drama	60 mins	Using the hand out presented you must now turn this plot summary into a performance whilst applying the skills of melodrama. It must include... Direct address Strong entrances and exits Develop stock characters Have clear concise dialogue that ensures your audience understands your storyline.
ICT	45 mins	Computer safety, file management and social networking
English	60 mins	Creative writing, SPAG, literary devices, extended writing, variety of sentences, vocabulary
History	60 mins	Similarities and differences, causation, inferences and source analysis
Music	60 mins	Students will need to be able to perform one of the songs they have been practising this term for example... 1 – Able to play the first 2 bars of Happy Birthday, right hand only 2 – Able to play all of Happy Birthday, right hand only 3- Able to play the first 2 bars of Twinkle, Twinkle, right hand only 4 -Able to play all of Twinkle, Twinkle, right hand only 5 – Able to play Happy Birthday, left hand and right hand 6 – Able to play Twinkle, Twinkle, left hand and right hand 7 – Able to play Bad Habits, right hand and left hand 8 – Able to play any of the above, right and left hand together 9 – Able to play Fur Elise (parts for both hands)
Art	60 mins	Black pen observational drawing of 4 shells using a different mark making technique for each shell (hatching, cross-hatching, scumbling, stippling)
MFL French and Spanish	60 mins	Pupils will need to show that they can write accurately in the language and read and understand short phrases in French or Spanish. Pupils will be tested on: functional vocabulary - dates, months, birthdays - written numbers and spelling 1-31, greetings and simple conversations.
